She studied jazz voice and guitar, received a fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts and developed a passion for jazz and a career spanning four decades, taking her to Washington DC, then New York City and later Los Angeles. With six internationally acclaimed CDs, she has headlined throughout the US as well as Turkey and Japan.
